## RAIN 2004

#### WHAT IS RAIN 2004?

RAIN is an annual ride across the state of Indiana, sponsored by the Bloomington Bicycle Club. Most of its 158 mile length runs on Route 40, an older four-lane road with light traffic and gentle rolling hills. In 2003, 838 riders started RAIN and 707 finished in the allotted time. The ride is brisk-paced and physically challenging. You should be able to average 12 to 14 mph for over 11 hours.
