WHAT IS RAIN 2002?

RAIN is an annual ride across the State of Indiana, sponsored by the Bloomington Bicycle Club. Its 162 mile length runs on Route 40, an older divided four-lane road with light traffic. It has gentle rolling hills. In 2001, 700 riders rode in RAIN. The ride is brisk-paced, and physically challenging. You should be able to average at least 12 to 14 mph for over 11 hours.

ACCOMMODATIONS: _____

The Drury/Peartree Inns of Terre Haute is RAIN2002 Headquarters. A special room rate of \$62.99 + tax for RAIN2002 participants has been arranged for a block of 95 rooms. Phone 1-812-238-1206 for the Drury Inn. The Signature Inn (across the street, phone 1-812-238-1461) also has a special room pricing of 56.00 + tax, for RAIN2002. SAFETY:

Riders MUST wear helmets. Riders must obey all Indiana traffic laws - this includes stopping at all stop signs and red lights. You must finish your ride by 8:00 p.m. (dark) to be an official finisher of RAIN 2002. This is a maximum of a 14 hour ride. Fanny flags will be provided.

REGISTRATION: _____

FEES for RAIN2002 are \$35.00 for each rider. You may pick up rider packets on Friday between 3:00 and 10:00 p.m. at the Drury Inn, or on Saturday morning between 4:30 and 5:15 a.m. only. Please register early (at least 2 weeks) so we can have the right amount of food at the rest stops. Your entry fee includes: t-shirt, fanny flag with your number, maps, instructions, 3 rest stops with food and drinks, full lunch stop, and a finish souvenir.

I understand that the route requires bicycling on public roadways and in bad weather and that cyclists have been hospitalized and killed because of traffic mishaps that are either their responsibility or others responsibility and I further agree that I will bear all expenses incurred in any such accidents

I realize that RAIN2002 requires physical conditioning and I represent that I am in sound medical condition. I have no physical or medical impediments which would endanger myself or others. I understand and agree that a situation may arise during RAIN2002 which may be beyond the control of the sponsors, promoters or organizers and agree to ride so as not to endanger either myself or others.

I waive, release, discharge for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives (including successors), any and all rights and/or claims which I have, may have or may hereafter accrue to me against the sponsors and promoters of RAIN2002 including the Bloomington Bicycle Club or their sponsors or affiliated organizations and their respective agents, officers and employees for any and all damages, injuries or claims which may be sustained by me indirectly arising out of my participation in RAIN2002. The above agreements and representations are my express understandings of the risks and I assume these voluntarily and freely without coercion or duress. This agreement may not be modified orally and may not be waived in any respect. I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my bicycle, will wear a helmet as required, and will carry water and personal identification at all times, and agree to abide by the rules of RAIN2002.
